This superior technology allows physicians to search online for electronic information recourses including books, periodicals and educational aids. In addition, it can be linked to medical libraries inside and outside the Kingdom to exchange the latest medical information.

Dr. Towerki explained that the e-library will be the first in the Kingdom to offer access to lectures and surgeries in the field of ophthalmology that are part of the training of fellows in the various subspecialties of ophthalmology. These lectures are given by physicians working at the Hospital and by visiting physicians from outside KKESH. The e-Library will also include recordings of complicated surgeries and information pertinent to the Fellowship Program to help physicians in the Kingdom to stay abreast of all the latest developments in the field of ophthalmology.

In the long run, the medical e-Library will contribute to providing outstanding medical treatment to ophthalmic patients in our beloved Kingdom as this knowledge is made available to all ophthalmic hospitals inside the Kingdom.
